

**City of Auburn's**  
**Endurance Capital Committee's Work Plan: 2013 – 2014**  
*(Background of ASRA Trail Safety & Etiquette Manual and User Group Meetings)*

Item #3: Create and publicize a Trail User Etiquette and Safety Manual for the Auburn State Recreation Area.

Item #4: Create and submit to the California State Parks an Auburn State Recreation Area plan for safe and fair trail access for all user groups, compiled by a joint collaboration among user groups that include pedestrians (runners, hikers, nature lovers), equestrians and mountain bike riders.

To that end, the Endurance Capital Committee hosted public meetings in September and October 2013 with the following mission:

“To develop a plan to present to the ASRA administrators that will satisfy the needs of Auburn State Recreation Area’s trail user groups (pedestrians, mountain bike riders, and equestrians) with respect and safety for all.”

After hosting three well-attended meetings and gathering a wealth of information from all the user groups, the ECC appointed a Subcommittee to work together to achieve the following goals, and return to the larger group with their plan.

- Select two to three existing trails in the Auburn State Recreation Area (ASRA) currently closed to mountain bikes to pilot test for use.
- Review usage of existing trails and potential usage designation changes for ASRA consideration.
